Please note the following in regarding these statistics:

- A 'report' is defined as a notification to the AFP, which alleges that a crime has been, is being, or may be committed.
- Where there are multiple victims identified, a separate report will be recorded for each victim.
- Where multiple offences are reported for the same victim, only the primary offence is represented (e.g., when a person reports being trafficking and in debt bondage).
- The reports are counted in the period they are received by the AFP, even if the alleged offence occur prior to the reporting period (e.g. an historical offence).
- The figures have not been revised after the collection period. (i.e. it was investigated as an HT matter but investigations revealed no offence being disclosed by the victim).
