## Update on traffic and access arrangements at Parliament House

Due to protest activity, ACT Policing is managing changed traffic arrangements around Parliament House for the coming sitting week **7-11 February 2022**.

Melbourne Avenue is the primary access road to Parliament House. ACT Policing advise that the Commonwealth Avenue ramp will be open from 08:00am to 17:30pm during this period, however this is subject to change.

Building occupants will not be able to access Parliament Drive from Kings Avenue or Federation Mall.

Building occupants wanting to enter the car parks or drop-off points will need to show identification (APH passes) to ACT Policing who are at the barricades.

For safety reasons, it is recommended that West Block car park is avoided as there should be adequate parking inside Parliament House.

These traffic arrangements are subject to change so please allow additional time to enter and exit the precinct.

### Building access

Access to the building for non-occupants is limited and only for essential parliamentary business purposes. Sponsored passes will be suspended for the sitting fortnight.

The turnstiles off Parliament Drive at the House of Representatives and Senate entrances have been activated for security pass access only.

As previously advised, the Main Front entrance has been temporarily closed.

The House of Representatives, Senate, Ministerial and main front basement (Point 1) entrances remain open to passholders.

Non-passholders are recommend to access the building via the main front basement (Point 1) entrance. Non-passholders with essential business in Parliament House will be required to pre-arrange access to the building and provide credentials to ACT Policing on arrival.

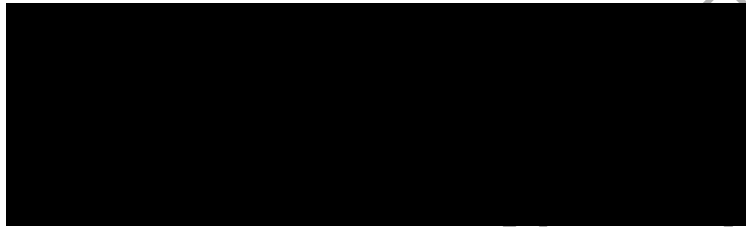
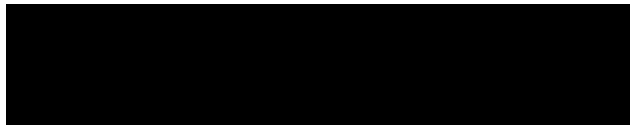

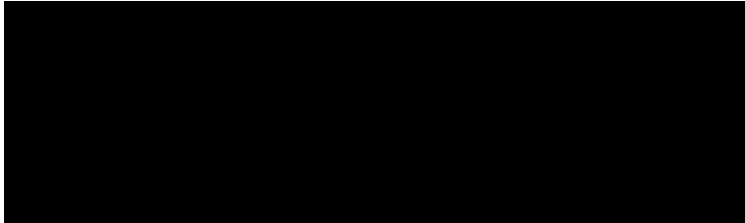

## Reminder: traffic and access arrangements at Parliament House

Due to protest activity, ACT Policing is managing changed traffic arrangements around Parliament House for the current sitting week **7-11 February 2022**.

Traffic conditions around Parliament House are expected to become more congested from 09:00am tomorrow, so building occupants should aim to arrive prior to this time. Melbourne Avenue is the primary access road to Parliament House. ACT Policing advise that the Commonwealth Avenue ramp will be open from 08:00am to 17:30pm during this period, however this is subject to change.

Building occupants will not be able to access Parliament Drive from Kings Avenue or Federation Mall.

Building occupants wanting to enter the car parks or drop-off points will need to show identification (APH passes) to ACT Policing who are at the barricades.

For safety reasons, it is recommended that West Block car park is avoided as there should be adequate parking inside Parliament House.

These traffic arrangements are subject to change so please allow additional time to enter and exit the precinct.

### Building access

Access to the building for non-occupants is limited and only for essential parliamentary business purposes. Sponsored passes are suspended for the sitting fortnight.

The turnstiles off Parliament Drive at the House of Representatives and Senate entrances have been activated for security pass access only.

As previously advised, the Main Front entrance has been temporarily closed.

The House of Representatives, Senate, Ministerial and main front basement (Point 1) entrances remain open to passholders.

Non-passholders are recommend to access the building via the main front basement (Point 1) entrance. Non-passholders with essential business in Parliament House are required to pre-arrange access to the building and provide credentials to ACT Policing on arrival.
