Australian Federal Police Association (AFPA) Enterprise Bargaining

On 2 September 2023, the AFP received a request to commence bargaining from the AFPA. This requires the AFP to issue the Notice of Employee Representational Rights (NERR) no later than 14 days later (by 16 September 2023 at the latest). The AFP anticipates meeting this requirement. The AFP is working with the Australian Public Service Commission to ensure we are well-positioned to commence bargaining negotiations in late-September. Further information on the AFP Enterprise Bargaining position will be provided to your office ahead of your meeting with the AFPA on 13 September 2023.

Enterprise Bargaining

On 14 September 2023, the Australian Public Service Commission approved the AFP's bargaining position, subject to financially linked caveats. The AFP issued its Notice of Employee Representational Rights to all non-SES employees on 15 September 2023, consistent with legislative requirements. The AFP intends to commence weekly bargaining meetings with employee representatives from 26 September 2023.

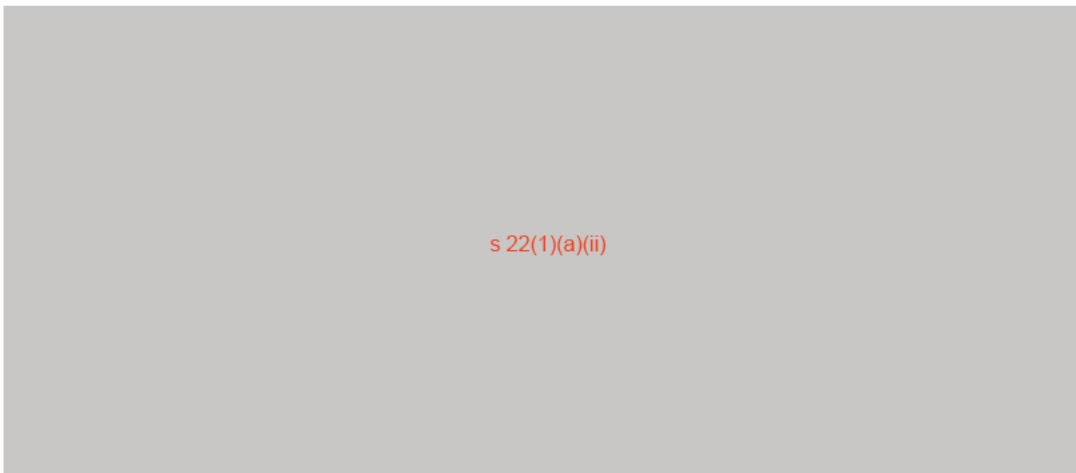

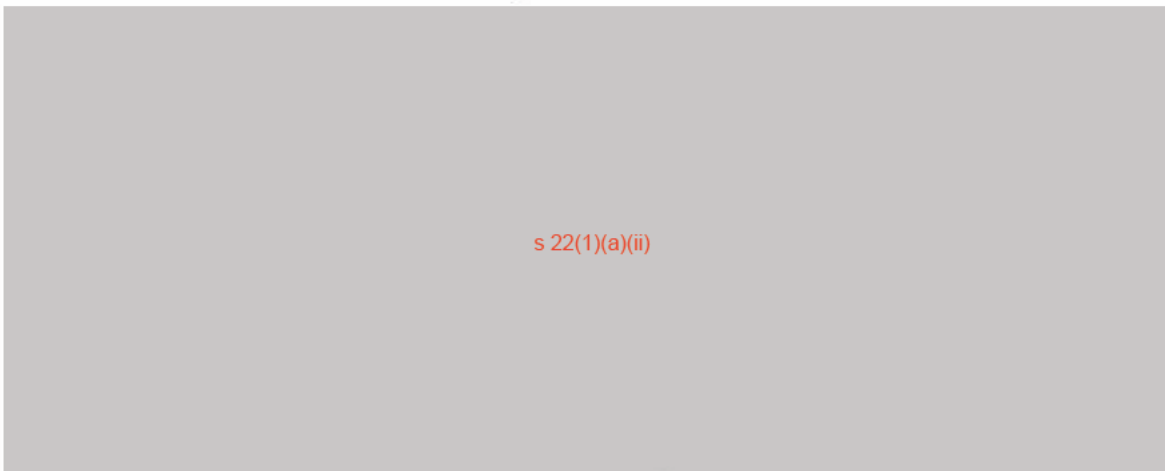

AFP Enterprise Bargaining

The AFP commenced enterprise bargaining on 26 September 2023, following a request from the Australian Federal Police Association. The Australian Public Service Commission (APSC) approved the AFP's bargaining position on 14 September 2023, with the caveat that items with a financial impact will be subject to further consideration. The AFP is continuing to work with the APSC on this including the requirement for a Funding and Remuneration Declaration to advance genuine negotiations on terms and conditions with a financial impact.
